

Discussion Guide – “Following Jesus” Series – Singles Ministry

Print a copy of this guide for each person in your group and give them 5–10 minutes to briefly consider it, making note of their immediate responses. Then, work through the questions together, and read the Scriptures mentioned to review and apply the material from the message.

Series Review

In Isaac’s first message, how did he define “disciple”?

What is one way your understanding of discipleship changed through this series?

Making Disciples

Our Responsibility: In Isaac’s message, he said, “To be committed to Christ’s mission means obeying His command to make other disciples.” Do you feel responsible for making disciples? Why or why not?

Christ’s Authority: What do you think hinders you from making disciples? Read Philippians 2:9-11 together. How does Jesus’ authority address those hindrances?

Christ’s Empowering Presence: When do you tend to forget that God is with you? How does remembering Christ’s presence empower you to make disciples? Have someone read Isaiah 41:10. How can you remind yourself of this truth this week?

Pray and Apply

Confess any sin that has kept you from obeying Christ, and ask the Holy Spirit to empower you to now obey Christ’s command to make disciples.

What believers has God called you to encourage, support and teach? Pray for them, and write down ideas about how to serve them.

What non-believers can you reach out to? Take time to pray for specific people, and write down ideas about how you can move toward them with the gospel of Jesus.
