Fellowship Starters:

- 1. Read Psalm 111:10-112:10 and open in prayer.
- 2. Discuss Robin's definition of wisdom quoted above. Two possible questions to be answered in that conversation might be: "How can we see the world as God sees it?" And, "Once we see it, what hope do we have to walk accordingly?"
- 3. Regarding the blessedness that comes from Wisdom, Robin said, "Blessedness means total joy in the presence of a completely loving and accepting God." Jesus has not only accomplished this blessedness for us, he also empowers us to walk in it ourselves through the Holy Spirit in relationship with God our Father. What is essential for us to grow in this reality and experience?
- 4. Close in prayer for one another, especially that we might grow in our pursuit of God and Wisdom through reading His Word.
