Fellowship Starters

- 1. Read Colossians 3:18-4:1 and Ephesians 5:15-33 together.
- 2. Open in prayer.
- 3. Discuss and remind one another of the central motivation that Paul roots his commandments and rules for Christian living in (See Col 2:6-7; 3:1-4, 17, 23-24)
- 4. Discuss how Paul's commandments for husbands and wives, parents and children, employers and employees really apply to any and all relationships in society? [In other words, though Paul is addressing these individual groups and roles in the church, the rest of the NT calls all Christians (married or single) to a life of humility, submission, obedience and love]
- 5. Discuss how the end goal of parenting is not blind obedience, but rather for children to understand how to live in a way that "pleases the Lord.".
- 6. End in prayer, focusing on the confidence that our great God will give abundant grace to anything and everything that he calls us to do in serving Him.
