Main Idea: Because God is awesome in His Holiness, we need a mediator in order to be reconciled with Him.

Sermon Outline:

1. God is awesome in His holiness.
2. Moses has a special role—Mediator.
3. The New Testament presents Jesus as the mediator of a new covenant.

Fellowship Starters:

1. Read Exodus 19:3 – 25 and open in prayer.
2. Discuss the transcendence and immanence of God. How does a better understanding and meditation on these characteristics of God's being lead us to worship him?
3. Discuss the Holiness of God. What images and scriptures come to mind that help us to understand it.
4. Discuss why the beauty, majesty and grandeur of God's Holiness should leave mankind in utter terror, as it did the Israelites at the foot of Mt. Sinai?
5. How was Moses a "type" or "shadow" of Christ? (Robin mentioned the roles of Prophet, Priest and Mediator).
6. Discuss the love and mercy of God in sending **the** mediator to "the world" (John 3:16).
7. Close in prayer for one another.
